

# Vitamin E with Selenium

Vitamin E and Selenium Supplement



## Description

To be used as a vitamin E and selenium supplement for all horses residing in selenium-deficient areas.

## Ingredients

Cornmeal, vitamin E supplement, dicalcium phosphate, saccharin sodium, sodium selenite.

Guaranteed Analysis Per Ounce:

Selenium	500 mcg
Vitamin E	1250 IU

## Feeding Directions

For use as a vitamin E and selenium supplement for all horses, dogs, cattle, and sheep receiving selenium-deficient diets.

Horses in training:	1-2 ounces once daily in feed
Broodmares:	1-2 ounces once daily in feed
Yearlings (>250 lb):	½ ounce once daily in feed
Weanlings and foals:	Consult veterinarian
Dogs:	½ tsp/10 lb body weight once daily in feed (maximum 4 tsp/ dog/ day)

### FDA limits total dietary selenium (Se) intake for cattle and sheep as follows:

Species	Feeding Directions	Total Dietary Se Intake Not To Exceed
Cattle:	6 oz/head/day	<b>3 mg total Se/head/day</b>
Calves:	5-6 oz/head/day	<b>3 mg total Se/head/day</b>
Sheep:	½ oz/head/day	<b>0.7 mg total Se/head/day</b>
Lambs (40-80 lb):	½-1 tsp/head/day	<b>0.7 mg total Se/head/day</b>

## Warning

For veterinary use only.

Selenium overdoses can be extremely toxic.

Do not exceed feeding directions.

The addition to feed of higher levels of this premix containing selenium is not permitted.

## Storage

Store in a cool, dry place. Keep lid tightly closed.

## Features

- May aid in preventing muscle cramps or signs of "tying up"
- Vitamin E plays a role in maintaining membrane stability and red blood cell integrity
- Selenium and vitamin E together work as antioxidants
- Good for supplementing horses living in selenium-deficient regions
